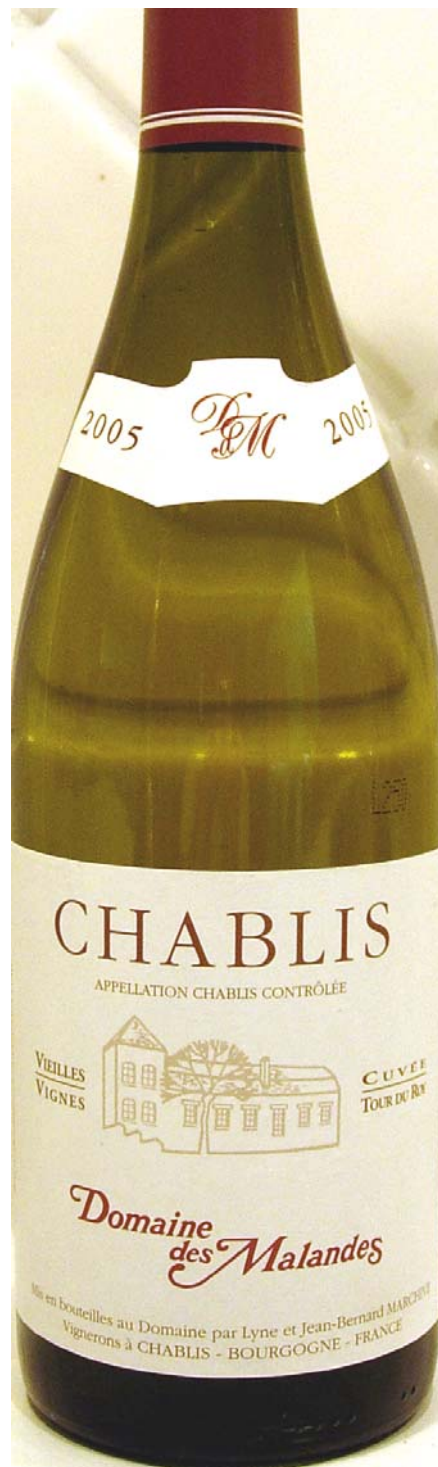
Where the Vine likes to live

The vine is 50 years old : concentrated, mineral, and pure, this Chablis is an excellent expression of his "terroir" very rich in Kimmeridgien clay.

The Chablis Old Vines « Tour du Roy » is located in the Vaudésir valley on the outer limits of the appellation Grand cru Vaudésir, about 50 miles south of Paris. It is harmonious and silky, with a palate-cleansing vigour.
